# "EDUROAM" USER GUIDE

## What is eduroam?

Eduroam is a secure, wireless service that allows students, faculty and staff to access the internet with their GW credentials across campus and when they visit other eduroam participated universities.

## ➤ How do I connect to eduroam?

#### Android:

- 1. Enable the wireless service on your device
- 2. Select the SSID "eduroam"
- 3. Select PEAP for the EAP method and MSCHAPV2 for phase 2 authentication
- 4. Enter your full university e-mail address (NetID@gwu.edu) for your identity
- 5. Enter the password that corresponds with your e-mail address
- 6. Select Connect

#### iPhone and iPad:

- 1. Enable the wireless service on your device
- 2. Select the SSID "eduroam"
- 3. Enter your full university e-mail address (NetID@gwu.edu) for your username
- 4. Enter the password that corresponds with your e-mail address
- 5. Accept the certificate from AddTrust, InCommon or rad\*\*\*\*.es.gwu.edu

#### Windows and Mac:

- 1. Select "eduroam" from your available SSID list
- 2. Enter your full university e-mail address (NetID@gwu.edu) for your username
- 3. Enter the password that corresponds with your e-mail address
- 4. Select Connect
